Our aims are to improve the working conditions and support structures for visual artists. We also act as a vital information point for artists with regard to issues that affect their professional practice.

Our policy is dedicated to facilitating an equal opportunities contemporary art practice for professional artists and to secure Backwater Artists Group as a permanently viable centre for the production of visual art. There is an artist-led Board of Directors.

Facilities available to artists include access to computer/scanner; darkroom facilities; digital and video cameras; mitre press and underpinner, woodwork area; data projector and monitor; slide copier; camera and tripod. We also facilities exhibitions, talks and events for our members in our exhibition/project space Studio 12.

Backwater Artists Group is a group studio with an ethos of shared skills and ideas for the promotion of visual arts. In order to fulfill this members have to give of their time and participate in the activities of the group.

Studios cost €135 per month.

Our Criteria is:

- (a) The artist must be willing to commit time to the activities of the group and use the studio space.
- (b) Allocation of spaces is conditional on a proven need for working studio space.
- (c) The Artist is a Professional Practising Artist.
- (d) Availability of studio space.
